

### **Teen Feng Shui**

*Session A1* 8:15-10:15

The Chinese art of placement, pronounced "fung schway," helps us build our personal environment by mapping the eight most important areas of our lives in accordance with the forces of nature. You will learn to create your unique map of your room and how colors, shapes, and materials affect your life to help you create positive energy in your world

### **Navigating Math Basic Skills**

*Session A1* 8:15-10:15

This program will review the topics in the math basic skills packet that each student must complete over the summer. The focus will be on the four basic math operations and on fractions, decimals, percents, variable expressions, and proportions.

### **SAT Math Prep**

*Session A1* 8:15-10:15

This course is designed for juniors and seniors who will be taking the SAT in 2009-2010. The following topics will be covered: numerical operations, Algebra I and functions, geometry and the coordinate plane, data analysis, probability, statistics, and some Algebra II. Test-taking strategies and skills will be an important component of the course. The students will work on actual SAT tests to reinforce their skills. Students need to purchase Barron's SAT, copyright 2008-2009 (24<sup>th</sup> edition).

### **Vocabulary Building:**

*Session A2* 10:30-12:30

This course will help improve your vocabulary skills in all your subjects through the study of Latin and Greek prefixes, roots, and suffixes. You will learn the differences between spoken and written language and how to improve your reading and writing skills.

### **Navigating English Basic Skills**

*Session A2* 10:30-12:30

Designed for incoming freshmen and sophomores, this course will review capitalization, punctuation, and paragraph organization skills. There will be attention given to the structure and design of the five-paragraph essay.

### **SAT Verbal/Essay Prep**

*Session A2* 10:30-12:30

This course is designed for juniors and seniors who will be taking the SAT in 2009-2010. In addition to building and practicing their verbal and writing skills, students will learn critical SAT strategies and tactics. They will work on actual SAT tests and learn to chart their SAT scores. Students will need to purchase Barron's SAT, copyright 2008-2009 (24<sup>th</sup> edition).

### **Theatre Clinic**

*Session B* 10:00-2:00

The clinic will consist of two workshops daily, with a brief lunch break. The first workshop will be a group voice class and a discussion of audition techniques. The second workshop each day will focus on acting skills and techniques. ### **Pre Calculus** 2.5 credits, graded

*Session C1* 8:15-10:15

must attend all 4 weeks

The course is a mandatory 4 week course for students who wish to enroll in AP Calculus directly from Honors Algebra II/Trigonometry. The course will cover the pre-Calculus topics necessary for success in AP Calculus.

### **Trigonometry** 2.5 credits, graded

*Session C1* 8:15-10:15

must attend all 4 weeks

The course is a mandatory 4 week course for students who wish to enroll in Honors Pre Calculus directly from Algebra II. The course will cover the trigonometry topics necessary for success in Honors Pre Calculus.

### **Dance Intensive**

*Session D1* 8:15-10:15 or *Session D2* 10:30-12:30,

This course serves as an introduction to the RBC Dance Program. Students involved in the Intensive will study a basic overview of ballet, jazz, modern, lyrical, musical theater, yoga, music video and choreography.

### **Yearbook Layout and Design (pre-Yearbook)**

*Session E* 8:30-11:30

This course is open to all students who have the desire to learn some techniques and style of desktop publishing layout and design which can be applied to the Yearbook, magazines, websites, brochures, CD/DVD cases and labels, and other mediums that incorporate images, text, graphics, and objects. An online publishing program will afford students the opportunity to actually create pages for publication, while some basic Photoshop components will be included to help the students to prepare images, photos, and graphics for use in same. Basic computer skills and proficiency with mouse management for drag-and-drop functions are helpful. **REQUIRED FOR INCOMING SENIOR YEARBOOK STUDENTS.**
